

Entry Terms and Conditions

All consignors of the 2025 Cornhusker Classic Sale agree to the following terms and conditions.

Dates to Note

- Entry Deadline: Friday, September 21, 2026, at 11:59 p.m.
- Barns Open: Tuesday, November 3, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.
- Check-In by: Thursday evening – November 5, 2026
- Sale Date: Friday, November 6, 2026, at 7:00 PM

Needed at time of check-in

- Signed registration papers
- Health papers

Sale Location

Held in conjunction with The NCC Fall Edition at the Buffalo County Fairgrounds in Kearney, Nebraska.

General Rules

1. All consignors must be a member of the Nebraska Hereford Association in good standing. Membership year begins October 1, 2025, and ends September 30, 2026.
 - NHA Membership (voting): \$100
 - NHA Commercial Membership: \$75
2. Cattle must be preconditioned and weaned.
3. The cattle sell under the standard terms and conditions recommended by the American Hereford Association.
4. Stalls will be assigned; bedding and pedigree signs will be provided. Consignors are welcome to bring ranch signs, stall dividers, tack, etc.
5. All scratches and/or substitutions will be at the discretion and approval of the Nebraska Hereford Association.
6. We strongly encourage all steer consignors to complete DNA testing on their steers prior to the sale. This follows the Junior Nationals Steer Show rules for any buyer who may want to take a calf to Junior Nationals. PLEASE NOTE, DNA TESTING WILL NOT BE MANDATORY FOR THE 2025 CORNHUSKER CLASSIC SALE.

Consignment and Sale Fees

1. Entry fee of \$250 per head and 10% commission. Consignment fee is non-refundable.
2. Entry fee shall be paid upon time of entry and prior to sale. Checks can be made to Nebraska Hereford Association and mailed to P.O. Box 23, Oconto, NE 68860

3. Nebraska Brand Inspection and Nebraska Beef Checkoff fees will be paid by consignors at time of sale and subtracted from consignor check.

Catalog Images, Information and Videos

1. Images and catalog footnotes are due Monday, October 6, 2025, at 11:59 PM. Consignors can re-enter their entry form to upload high-resolution files or email files to nehereford@gmail.com.
2. The NHA will host a picture and video day. Depending on need we will offer to picture and video cattle on both October 4 and 5, 2025. Location is TBD and will reflect a central location for Cornhusker Classic Consigners.

Cornhusker Classic No-Sale Policy

1. Consignors with cattle that have walked through the sale ring and “no-sale” will be subject to pay the 10% commission day of the sale.

Certificate of Registration and Identification

1. All animals must be registered with the American Hereford Association by entry deadline, September 19, 2025. Certificate of registration must be available and signed by seller upon check-in.
2. It is the obligation of the seller to make sure that each animal sold has a readable tattoo corresponding to the registration paper.
3. Brand papers must be provided if living in brand inspection area.

Health Requirements

The Nebraska Hereford Association and Cornhusker Classic Sale, in cooperation with the Nebraska State Veterinarian's Office and the Nebraska Department of Agriculture, recognizes and abides by the pertinent laws of the state of Nebraska. A veterinarian will be on-call for the duration of the Cornhusker Classic Sale.

1. All animals entering the Cornhusker Classic Sale must be accompanied by a current Certificate of Veterinary inspection (CVI) and shall have official identification listed on the CVI to be allowed on grounds.

Each CVI must:

- a. Be issued by an accredited licensed veterinarian.
 - b. Show name and address of owner or exhibitor.
 - c. Show all required tests and/ or vaccinations.
 - d. Be issued within thirty (30) days of the sale.
3. Females must be bangs vaccinated.
 2. Under no circumstances may animals under quarantine be sold.
 3. Any evidence of warts, ringworm, pinkeye, draining abscesses or any other contagious disease will eliminate cattle from the fairgrounds.

The Nebraska Hereford Association reserves the right to reject cattle not meeting above requirements or any cattle at their discretion.

Nebraska Hereford Association 2026 Futurity Show Eligibility

1. Junior steer and heifer buyers are eligible to enter the 2026 Nebraska Hereford Association Futurity Show held in conjunction with the Nebraska Junior State Show in June.
2. Buyer number must be registered in the name of exhibiting junior.
3. Junior buyer must pay \$25 entry fee at time of sale otherwise forfeit the animal's futurity show eligibility.

2. Consignors/Buyers may keep their sale stalls for the duration of the weekend.
